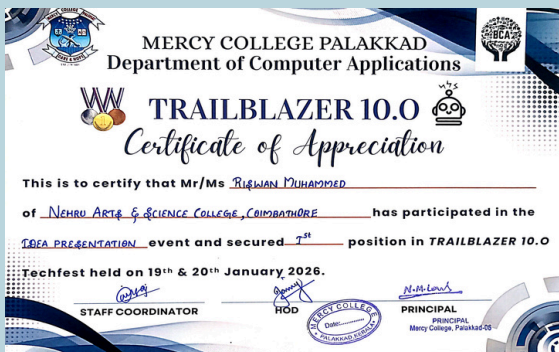
Tree Plantation
